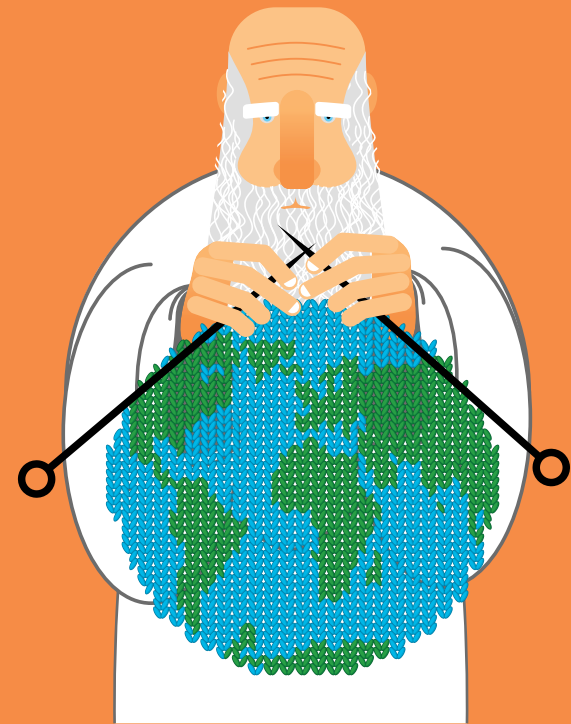

Day 7

Craft

You need:

Paper, crayons

What to do: Draw a picture of your favorite way to rest. It could be napping, laying in a hammock or simply sitting on the couch.

Game: Quiet Game

How to: Every one sits down and does not move. When you say go no one can talk or move they have to sit still and not talk for how ever long you want. Who ever stays quiet the longest wins.

Family Activity

You need:

Sheets, Blankets or a small tent

What to do: Build a fort with bed sheets and blankets, or put up a tent in your living room or outside. Hang out in it all night, talk to each other and play games. This is a great time for no screens.

Day 7

Read:

Genesis 2:1-3

Understanding:

God Rested

The activities on the next page, will help your family engage in today's devotion.

We encourage you to read from a physical Bible and not your phone. If all you have is your phone then please use it.

We designed this so you can teach the Bible to your children and have great family time. Truly engage with your children and you will see wonderful things come out of them. This is also designed to go day by day but you could spend a week just doing one of these devotions.

Go at your own pace and dive in deeper to Gods word as a family, it makes a huge difference.

Day 1

Read:

Genesis 1:1-5

Understanding:

God formed the earth by speaking it, He started with light and making it day and night.

The activities on the next page, will help your family engage in today's devotion.

Day 6

Craft: Animal Drawing

You need:

Paper, crayons

What to do: If you have toy animals place them in the sun so it creates a shadow on the paper. Have the children outline the shadow of as many animals as they can or that you have. Then have them color it in.

Game: Charades

How to: Gather your family together and choose an animal but do not tell anyone what your animal is. One at a time act out your animal with out words. Try and guess what they are if you get it right then you get to go next.

Family Activity

What to do: Go to a farm or zoo. Look at all the different types of animals God created. All of them have a purpose. Some of them can look funny and some of them can act funny but God saw that it was good.

Day 6

Read:

Genesis 1:24-31

Understanding:

God created all the animals,
and He created you to be just
like Him

The activities on the next page,
will help your family engage in

Day 1

Craft

You need:

Paper, crayons

What to do: Draw a picture of night and day

Game: Flashlight Tag

You need:

Flashlight

How to: One person is "it" and everyone else hides. The person that is "it" uses the flashlight to find everyone else. Once you are found you are out and wait for everyone to be found. Choose a new person to be "it" and keep playing till everyone gets a chance to be "it". This represents the light that shown.

Family Activity

You need:

Sheets, Blankets and Flashlight or hang up some lights

What to do: Build a fort with bed sheets and blankets, try to make it as dark as possible. If you want to use lights hang them up while you are building the fort to make sure they stay up. Tell the story of God forming the night and day and as you say day turn on the lights!

Day 2

Read:

Genesis 1:6-8

Understanding:

God created a space between heaven and earth and He named it sky.

The activities on the next page, will help your family engage in today's devotion.

Day 5

Craft: Bird Feeder

You need:

Paper roll, Peanut Butter, and bird seed

What to do: Take the paper roll and cover it in peanut butter. Then cover it in bird seed. Stick it on a branch or tie a string through it and tie it to a tree.

Game: Shark and Minnows

How to: One person is the "shark" the rest of you are "minnows". The "minnows" line up on one side of the room or yard and try to make it to the other side of the room. The "shark" will run at you from the opposite direction and try to tag someone. Once you have been tagged you join the "shark" and you keep going until there is no "minnows" left.

Family Activity

What to do: Visit an aquarium or pet store. Look at all the fish and see how many you can name. Have the children draw their favorite fish, this can be done there or at home.

Day 5

Read:

Genesis 1:20-23

Understanding:

God created all the birds
in the sky and the fish in
the sea.

The activities on the next page,
will help your family engage in
today's devotion.

Day 2

Craft: Painting in a Bag

You need:

Paper, Paint, storage bag, tape

What to do: Put the paper in the storage bag, then add your paint on top of the paper, seal the bag. Tape the bag down to your table or floor. Once it is secure have your child push the paint around in the bag creating a masterpiece. This represents the waters and the sky.

Game: Balloon in the Air

You need:

Balloon

How to: Blow up the balloon, not with helium. Have your child keep the balloon in the air by tapping it with their hand and letting it fall but tap it again before it hits the ground. The goal is for the balloon not to hit the ground. This represents the space between the waters.

Family Activity

What to do: Go outside and look at the sky, see how many cloud shapes you can find.

Day 3

Read:

Genesis 1:9-13

Understanding:

God created the ground we walk on, the seas we swim in and the trees and plants that we eat from. God created everything we need

The activities on the next page, will help your family engage in today's devotion.

Day 4

Craft

You need:

Paper, crayons

What to do: Draw a picture your favorite season.

Game: Clean up the Snow

You need:

Paper/cotton balls, buckets

How to: Use paper or cotton balls, if you are using paper crumble it into balls to create "snow". Scatter your "snow" around a room set the buckets on one side of the room. Have your children pick up the "snow" as fast as they can and put it in to the buckets. God created all the seasons and it is beautiful.

FamilyActivity

What to do: You have to do this at night so make sure you are in a safe area. Get a blanket if you want and lay out under the sky as a family. See if you can find any constellations like the big dipper or just look at the amazing work God did with the stars.

Day_4

Read:

Genesis 1:14-19

Understanding:

God created the stars, the moon, the sun and all of the seasons.

The activities on the next page, will help your family engage in today's devotion.

Day_3

Craft: Plant something

You need:

Dirt, seeds and water

What to do: You can either plant seeds of vegetables or flowers. Explain that this takes time to grow but when God did spoke it, it happened immediately. We will take our time and water it and watch it grow.

Game: Scavenger Hunt

You need:

Digital or print out of the hunt page

How to: Use the scavenger hunt check list on the next page to go look for some of the creation God has created. You can have the children collect them or just point the items out.

Family Activity

What to do: Take your family to an orchard, a nature walk or a park. Look at all the plants and trees. Use the scavenger hunt help keep the children engaged. Just take in the amazing things God has created.
